  - the involvement and empowerment of employees regarding on environmental protection
  - the implementation of measures to prevent and limit pollution in all its activities
  - the involvement and strengthening of consciousness of relevant stakeholder regarding on the environmental protection
  - preferring suppliers who can provide services as much as possible in accordance with the adopted environmental management system
  - contracting out services to transport operators and disposal plant of waste that ensure suitable waste
  - transport in order to reduce the impact from air emissions and favoring recovery activities rather than disposal
  - rationalization of energy consumption
  - communication of environmental sustainability principles to suppliers, customers and the relevant stakeholders for the environmental management system
  - defining environmental targets, considering the knowledge of the context and environmental impacts of its activity, integrated with the operative management of the Company

The Management sets targets and is responsible for monitoring and reviewing them periodically to assess the achieved results and to identify new ones in accordance with the Quality principle of continuous improvement. Policy and targets are communicated to workers in order to disseminate the principles and to ensure and to disclose the knowledge.
